- 23 **2014 Merlot/Grenache IGP Pays d`Oc, Les Vignes de L`Eglise, France** £19.50 £5.00
Smooth on the palate with medium to full body and integrated supple tannins. Juicy, easy to drink, with a touch of spice on the long, fruit-driven finish.
- 24 **2014 Rioja Tempranillo, Señorío de Uñuela, Rioja, Spain** £21.00 £5.35
Clean and bright, with aromas of fresh red fruit and liquorice so characteristic of the Tempranillo.
- 37 **2014 Pinot Noir, Tinpot Hut, Marlborough, New Zealand** £33.00
Soft and silky with classic black cherry notes and lovely aromatic qualities.

Mid-weight Red Wines

- 25 **2014 Chianti, Da Vinci, Tuscany, Italy** £23.50 £5.80
Bright, youthful and ruby red in colour. Attractive red fruit aromas lead to a palate full of juicy, ripe berry fruit and hints of smoke and spice. A lifted, fresh wine that finishes on a perfumed, blackberry note.
- 36 **2013 Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso, Torre del Falasco, Veneto, Italy** £29.50
Dried cherry and dark plums followed by hints of mocha and dark chocolate.
- 257 **2007 Château Tour de Grenet, Lussac-Saint-Émilion, France** £31.00
This is the level at which serious claret really starts to shine. A real taste of the terroir with a lovely gravelly attack followed by austere fruit and good length.
- 205 **2011 Pinot Noir, Bernhard & Reibel, France** £35.00
Pinot Noir lends itself to medium-bodied, slightly more austere wines. This is a tremendous food wine and possibly the most exciting Pinot Noir we have seen for ages.
- 260 **2012 Mercurey Vieilles Vignes, Albert Sounit, Burgundy, France** £39.00
Relatively full-bodied for a red Burgundy. Bags of character and structure and, coming from a less well-known Village, extremely good value.

Richer and Full-Flavoured Red Wines

- 35 **2014 Montepulciano d`Abruzzo `La Bella Addormentata`, Gran Sasso, Italy** £21.00 £5.35
Intense, ripe-fruit bouquet. Full bodied with good, supple tannins supporting the juicy fruit.
- 26 **2014`I Muri` Primitivo, Vigneti del Salento, Puglia, Italy** £25.00 £6.75
Deep ruby red colour with violet reflections. This wine has red berry fruit perfumes with a hint of spice. Full-bodied with firm tannins, this wine is well balanced with lots of ripe fruit flavours.
- 27 **2014 Malbec Clasico, Altos Las Hormigas, Mendoza, Argentina** £25.00 £6.75
Silky with very delicate tannins, along with mango and plum notes. On the finish, sweet spices and dried herbs linger with a natural acidity.
- 28 **2013 Shiraz, Dandelion Vineyards, Barossa Valley, Australia** £28.00 £7.25
Generous mouth-filling sweet blackberry, raspberry and plums cover the palate with lashings of sweet spice. Firm but fine tannins and dark chocolaty nuances continue throughout the lengthy palate with youthful finish.
- 349 **2006 Rioja Reserva, Ruiz de Viñaspre, Laguardia, Spain** £32.50
Rich and round, long and complex. An aspirational Rioja.

FINE WINES

- 266 **2010 Saint-Émilion Grand Cru, Château Piganeau, Bordeaux, France** £48.00
Lots going on in terms of depth and concentration, this claret is going to appeal to those who know Saint Emilion as it shows tremendous local typicity.
- 29 **2006 Charmes Chambertin Grand Cru, Jean-Claude Boisset, Burgundy, France** £150.00
Top-flight Burgundy: On the palate, the wine is delicate but intense, with a very fine balance between supple tannins and ripe, spicy fruit.
- 309 **1994 Côte-Rôtie, Clusel-Roche, Rhône, France** £75.50
A bold and fully mature Rhône red.
- 30 **2011 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rouge `Val de Dieu`
Château de Vaudieu, Southern Rhône, France** £80.00
Exotic flowers and graphite along with a smoky minerality and hints of chocolate. Full-bodied, this rich, concentrated red from the Southern Rhône has a light elegant texture and superb balance.
- 306 **2010 Amarone della Valpolicella, Le Bignele, Veneto, Italy** £55.00
Dried grapes are used to make this legendary wine. The result is a rich and full red with a lingering sweetness. Beautiful.
- 307 **2009 Barolo Tre Ciabot, Cascina Ballarin, Piemonte, Italy** £60.00
Monster red from the Piemonte region of Northern Italy. All the ingredients; weight, alcohol, fruit, acidity and tannins are on a large scale but the balance is fantastic. For the aficionado!
- 31 **2007 Barolo, Poderi Aldo Conterno, Piemonte, Italy** £96.00
Intensely perfumed nose, with floral notes and a touch of mint lifting the ripe dark fruit.
